Extemporaneous Speaking	<p>In the virtual prep room:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Computers, electronic storage and retrieval devices are permitted. • Connectivity with any person inside or outside the virtual prep room is not permitted. Students may only contact the Extemp Prep Room Monitors. • Materials can be on files on their computers or retrieved from an attached thumb, flash, or hard drive. • Prepared speeches are not allowed. <p>In the virtual competition rooms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No notes (electronic or otherwise) may be used during the delivery of the speech.
Team Policy CX Debate, Lincoln-Douglas Debate, Public Forum Debate, Student Congress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Computers, electronic storage and retrieval devices are permitted. • Connectivity for search and retrieval is permitted. • Electronic communication is permitted only with the assigned judges and competitors within the virtual competition room. • Electronic communication through wired or wireless networks, cell phones, etc. with any other person, outside the virtual competition room is not permitted. (Students may NOT communicate with coaches, squad members, or anyone EXCEPT their debate partner..)
